CONDITION OF ENTRY



Contractors are required to carry proof of vaccination at all times, and show proof of vaccination.

At this stage, the ServiceWA app does not show the booster date, so it is not an acceptable form of proof of booster vaccination. We recommend downloading the digital certificate from MyGov/ Medicare (showing all three vaccination dates) on your mobile device or carrying a printed copy.

WA GOVERNMENT'S BOOSTER VACCINATION DIRECTIVE

All contractors who regularly attend CSBP Kwinana or Kleenheat sites in Western Australia are expected to comply with the WA Government mandate requiring ALL personnel to have the COVID-19 third vaccination (booster) when eligible.

The mandate excludes contractors that make a one-off visit to any site on a single day. If unsure if this exclusion applies to you, contact your respective WesCEF Responsible Officer.

MASKS

Surgical or P2 masks must be worn on WesCEF premises. Cloth masks cannot be worn as they do not provide an acceptable level of protection.

People are expected to bring their own masks. In exceptional circumstances, masks can be requested at reception or security gatehouses on a case-by-case basis.

Surgical masks must be changed daily or immediately if they become wet or soiled. A P2 mask can provide protection for a week and doesn't have to be changed daily unless damaged or it becomes wet.

COVID TESTING APPROACH

WesCEF is developing a Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT) Safety Standard to guide our approach about their use in the workplace. This will be shared with you in a future update.

In the meanwhile, please inform the WesCEF Medical Centre when any of your employees who have attended a WesCEF site have tested positive for COVID.

DAILY HEALTH CHECK

This Daily Health Check must be completed every day prior to attending a WesCEF site.

In the past 14 days have you...

- Or anyone you live with tested positive for COVID-19?
- Been in close contact with someone who has tested positive?
- Visited a COVID-19 exposure site and have yet to be tested?
- Are you currently awaiting the result of a COVID-19 test?
- Had any of the following symptoms in the last 24 hours?

Fever with a temperature of over 38°, cough with or without phlegm, shortness of breath, muscle/joint pains, sore throat, runny nose or frequent sneezing

If you answered YES to any of these questions:

- please do not enter a WesCEF site.
- inform your supervisor and WesCEF Responsible Officer that you're unable to attend site.
- get tested as soon as possible.
